



Miguel DE BRUYCKER

Miguel De Bruycker became Managing Director of the Centre for Cybersecurity Belgium on August 17, 2015.

Prior to his appointment, he headed the Computer Security Incident Response Capability unit at the Belgian Ministry of Defence.

Miguel De Bruycker joined the General Intelligence and Security Service of the Ministry shortly after writing a dissertation on Cyber Defence in 2005. In his role, he was responsible for the security of classified networks and the creation of the first cybersecurity unit of the Belgian Ministry of Defence. Since 2008, he and his cyber team have been involved in the processing of all major cyber incidents in Belgium.

In his previous function, De Bruycker also headed the Cyber and CIS (Communications and Information Systems) Security unit of the Belgian military intelligence service.

He studied at the Royal Military School and the Vrije Universiteit Brussel, Brussels.
